# Yahshua is Victory, Deliverance and Salvation

- Yahshua has been made unto us Wisdom, Righteousness, Sanctification and Redemption – 1 Corinthians 1:30.
- Wisdom – knowledge and the capacity to make due use of it.
- Righteousness – right standing, rightness or being upright.
- Sanctification – renewal of our fallen nature by the Holy Ghost, received through faith in Jesus Christ, whose blood of atonement cleanseth from all sin, whereby we are not only delivered from the guilt of sin, but are washed from its pollution, saved from its power, and are enabled through grace, to love God.
- Redemption – deliverance from sin and freedom from captivity.

# Victory – to Overcome --

- 1 John 5:4 – For everyone born of God overcomes the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world, even our faith.
- Deut: 20:4 – for the Lord your God is the one who goes with you to fight for you against your enemies to give you victory.
- 1 Corinthians 10:13 – No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; He will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it.
- John 6:13 – I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world.

# Victory – Freedom – Deliverance

- 2 Cor. 3:17 – Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is there is freedom/liberty.
- John 8:32 – and you will know the truth and the truth will set you free.
- Ps. 118:5. -- Out of my distress, I called on the Lord; the Lord answered me and set me free.
- John 8:36 – So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.
- Romans 6:22 – But now that you have been set free from sin and have become slaves of God, the fruit you get leads to sanctification and its' end, eternal life.

Testify – a solemn declaration, bear witness, serve evidence or proof, personal conviction.

- Rev. 12:11 – they triumphed over him by the blood of the lamb and by the word of their testimony; they did not love their lives so much as to shrink from death.
- Ask yourself – what is your testimony? What will your legacy be? What are you giving to others? And what are you known for?

# Solemn Declaration

- What do I stand for?
- What do I believe?
- What do I think the most important things are to teach?
- Write them down
- Example – Jesus is Lord. He is coming back again. Faith in Him guarantees eternal life. Love your neighbor as yourself. Seek, knock and Ask. Forgive. Love. Do not covet. Faith comes by hearing. Believe the best in people. Prayer works. God doesn't lie. God speaks to us. Judge not. Call the end from the beginning. Create.
